



CIRAD HISTORY IN VIETNAM

- End 80's - beginning 90's: Cirad FLHOR, CP et TERA
- 1994: EMVT at Can Tho university (aquaculture)
- 1998: MOU on SAM between MARD, Cirad, IRRI, IRD
- 2000: MOU with MARD on the establishment of a "non official" representative office in Hanoi
- 2001: SMOU between NIAH and EMVT
- 2002: creation of the Malica PCP
- 2003: starting signature of the FSP / FFEM BIODIVA Project (4 M€)
- 2003: SMOU CLRRI (Rice)
- 2003: creation of the Prise PCP
- 2006: formal agreement on an "official" representative office in Hanoi



- FSP from MAE

- Projects won with Asia Pro Eco (EU), Genaviflu (ANR), AIRD..
- CGIARs' contributions (IRRI, AVRDC...), IFAD, FAO), challenge programme (CPWF)
- Expertise (ADB, FAO, etc.. plus AFD)
- More and more important counterparts from Vietnamese authorities

ACQUIRED RESULTS IN VIETNAM

- Strong and trusted vietnamese partnerships
- A good local and regional image on scientific aspects with obtained and validated results
- A very positive experience of the PCP concept (but not stabilized)
- Very good results on university degrees and qualifying education of partners (numerous thesis, masters, individual training courses and workshops...)
- Good results in terms of scientific articles in co-publication (> 100 articles in IF journals)
